Meeting Order Business:

1) Meeting called to order at 8:15 AM with Pledge of Allegiance, Welcome, and Sign in.

- 3) Treasurer's Report Lindsay presented and stated it remains unchanged for the most part since last report. General Fund: \$21,911.86, Playground Fund: \$12,182.04, Working Budget: \$9,729.82. Last Box Tops count was \$433.10, Movie Night Event: -101.77 loss, Chick-fil-a Night Fundraiser: \$165.00, Teacher Gifts (Valentine's Day, Teacher Appreciation, Color Bash, reams of paper and gift cards): \$1,300.00 (all staff and teachers got \$25.00 gift cards)

Old Business/Committee Items:

- 1) Playground Will get done this summer (at least Dr. McGee wants to try for it to be done by then).
- 2) Pop Tabs –Turn in and weigh day is Tuesday, April 3rd. Darcia and Audra to work out details.
- 3) Burns got the \$246,000 funding for future projects, buildings, etc. but need continued support.
- 4) March 5, 2018 from 1-5PM in Deland for the Charter High School Meeting (200 N. Clara Ave.)

New Business:

1) Teacher Grants (several to approve) – Mr. Z robot grant \$325.61, Dr. McGee Scholarship donations for student Color Bash t-shirts \$300.00, Ms. Watson Insect Bag/Butterfly Garden \$34.95, Mrs. Miller Match Learning Center (that will last several years) \$279.38, Mrs. Wood Instant Learning Games covering several topics \$220.30, Ms. Alois Science/Ant Habitat and living things (reusable) with reading and sight word recognition \$240.00, Ms. Kimmick headphones for lab and testing \$98.53, Coach Chris Basketball Hoop \$197.00, Mrs. Betts 18 students Board Games and indoor recess tools: World Fun Legos and Pop to win Math (from Lake Shore) \$78.00.
