

## BOARD MEETING June 16, 2020 6:00 p.m. Meeting Minutes

- 1. Call to Order: Meeting called to order at 6:01 p.m.
- 2. Pledge of Allegiance.
- 3. Roll Call: Mr. Landers, Mrs. Greene, Ms. Reiker, Mr. Demers, Mr. Amalfitano, Mrs. Mohrman And Mr. Glugover all present at roll call. Mr. Catheline absent.
- 4. Approval of Minutes: Motion to approve April 21 minutes by Mr. Amalfitano. 2nd by Mrs. Reiker.

  - a. SEV Lawsuit was decided on June 8, 2019 and SEV must submit a new charter and remove all reference of BST, Dr. McGee and Mr. Hargrave from new charter. They plan to open in 2021 if new charter is approved.

After the district releases the VCSD re-opening plan, BST will have a workshop to discuss the best options for BST: online classes, distance learning, staggered days, brick and mortar school, masks, plexi-glass dividers, arrows on walkways, limited participation for lunch, playground, etc., School sanitizing and bus capacity/sanitizing continues to be an issue.
    - 2. It takes one year to be approved for becoming and online school. Our students and staff need social/emotional skills to work through this pandemic.
